Problematic:

Mining Law No. 25-12 was promulgated with the objective of enhancing the economic sovereignty and improving the investment environment in the mining sector, which is considered as a strategic sector. It introduces a set of incentive measures as a part of the reforms intended to diversify the national incomes resources beyond the hydrocarbons sector, with the emphasis on promoting the transparency in the mining activities, creating the direct and indirect employment opportunities and in addition to promoting the small and medium-sized enterprises in the exploration and prospecting activities.

However, the mining sector in Algeria faces numerous obstacles, most notably the absence of an accurate geological and mining database, besides the lack of the new exploitable discoveries and the near-total lack of the foreign investment and the limited domestic production of certain mineral resources, contributing to a continued increase in the mineral imports despite their domestic availability.

In this regard, Law No. 25-12 intends to promote the mining investment within a stable legal and institutional framework, based on the development of the geological infrastructure and the guarantee of the free access to information for the initiation of the exploration projects, thereby raising the following issue:

Regarding the contribution of Law No. 25-12 to improving and promoting both national and foreign investment, without affecting the State's sovereignty over its mineral resource?

Conference Objectives:

- The National Conference aims to:
- Clarify the various incentive measures included in Law 25-12 intended to promote the investment in the mining sector.
 - Outline the mechanisms for enhancing transparency in the mining sector.
 - Evaluate the potential for the economic diversification beyond the hydrocarbons and the creation of the employment in the mining sector.
 - Examine the main reasons for eliminating the 51/49 rule for the foreign investment in the mining sector, retaining it only for quarries.

Conference Themes :

Theme 1: Conceptual and Regulatory Framework of the Mining Activities in Algeria.

(Strategic Character of the Mining Sector, Exploration and Prospecting Activities, Mining Exploitation, Artisanal Mining, Mining Operators, etc..)

Theme 2: Institutional Framework of the Mining Activities in Algeria.

(Economic Regulation of the Mining Activities, National Mining Agency, Geological Survey in Algeria, Ministry of Energy and Mines, etc..)

Theme 3: Procedural Framework of the Mining Activities in Algeria.

(Mining Titles, legal Transactions Relating to Mining Titles, One-Stop System, Support for Local Content, Licensing Application Processing, etc...)

Theme 4: Prospects and Challenges of the Foreign Investment in the Mining Sector.

(Unlicensed Mining Activities, Incentives for Mining Investment, etc...)

Participation Conditions:

- The intervention topic should reflect an academic originality and serious presentation aligned with the conference themes.
- The intervention must not be published, submitted for publication, or previously presented in other scientific works.
- Joint interventions are not accepted, except the contributions submitted by the PhD student with his supervisor
- Research papers should be edit in:

Arabic language: sakkal Majalla font, size 16(headers) and 12(footnotes).

French language: Times New Roman font, size 14(headers) and 12(footnotes).

- The number of the pages should not be less than 10 pages and not exceed 15 pages.

-Footnotes should be continuously formatted at the bottom of each page.

-The interventions are accepted in Arabic or English, attached to an abstract in a foreign language other than that of the conference.

- The associate professor form should include the full name, academic rank, affiliated institution, phone number and email address, intervention theme and title.

- The proceedings of the conference will be published in the form of a book with an International Standards Book Number (ISBN)
