- ✦ Addressing the challenges facing the reform of governmental support policy in Algeria.
- ✦ Presenting successful experiences of countries that have transitioned from universal to targeted support systems, and deriving lessons from these experiences.
- ✦ Anticipating the future of support policy in Algeria in light of economic and financial changes affecting the country.
- ✦ Highlighting mechanisms for transitioning from universal to targeted support in Algeria to alleviate the general budget deficit, which has become a significant challenge, especially given the volatility of oil prices in international markets.

The statement of the problem of forum

The concept of generalized social support in Algeria has been associated with the project of the social state, which has been pursued since independence to the present day in order to maintain the purchasing power of the poor and low-income class in society. This has been achieved by allocating significant financial resources to cover the expenses of various social support programs. However, this has resulted in numerous negative repercussions affecting economic, social, financial, and security aspects. Given the continuous increase in the cost of social support programs and their competition with public investment funding, as well as their contribution to the increase and persistence of the general budget deficit and other reasons, Algeria needs to reform its social support system by gradually redirecting it and attempting to benefit from the experiences of some pioneering countries in this field, while taking into account the nature of Algerian society. Based on the aforementioned points, the following issue for the forum arises: **What mechanisms can be adopted within a policy framework to gradually reform the universal social support system in Algeria, taking into account the society's nature?**

Participation requirements

Those wishing to participate should submit complete research papers on one of the listed axes (in Arabic, English, French). The following conditions must be met:

The submitted research should be original, following scientific methodology, and not published or submitted for publication or participation in another scientific event. The research should be written in Word, not exceeding 20 pages and not less than 12 pages, including margins and references listed at the end of the research paper. Writing in Arabic should use Simplified Arabic font, size 14, with 1.15 line spacing, and size 11 for margins. Writing in Latin languages should use Times New Roman font, size 12, with 1.15 line spacing, and size 11 for margins, considering a 2 cm margin from all sides.
