Industrial handling in Algeria's SMEs remains are faced many obstacles, as demonstrated by the weak interconnectedness between large industrial enterprises and small and medium-sized enterprises. In addition to their limited role in raising the performance of the industrial sector, which has kept their performance limited, and their growth rates and productive capacities weak.
