## Conference Preblomatic :

The marine environment is of great importance, serving as a primary source of biological, energy and mineral resources. However, it has recently threatened by various sources of pollution, such as petroleum, industrial waste, radioactive substances carried by ships and other hazardous substances and products.

Considering the gravity of the present situation, which poses a real threat to the marine environment, the international efforts have been strengthened to develop an integrated legal regime, obligating States to undertake explicit responsibilities for prevention and protection.

The implementation of these international obligations at the national level raises complex legal issues notably concerning the compatibility of the international norms with the unique particularities and the diversity environmental and economic conditions of the coastal States, as well as the variations in the legislative and institutional capacities, together with the national sovereignty and developmental requirements.

Accordingly, the main issue examined in the present study may be presented as a central question, as follows: To what extent it is possible to reconcile the international legal obligations for the marine environment protection with the respect of the national particularities. Moreover, what are the legal mechanisms can ensure the legal protection of the marine environment without prejudice to the exercise of the national sovereignty and the requirement of the sustainable development?

## Conference Objectives :

- 1-To highlight the international legal framework governing the protection of the marine environment.
- 2-To underscore the particularities of the national legislations on the marine environment protection, and to assess their alignment and coherence with the international obligations.
- 3-To evaluate the effectiveness of the national legal mechanisms for the prevention against the marine pollution and the protection of the marine resources.
- 4-To highlight the role of the judiciary and the competent authorities in reinforcing the legal protection of the marine environment and in implementing the legal liability for the environmental harms.
- 5-To examine the current legal issues besides the suggestion of the practical solutions seek to develop the environmental policies and the environmental governance.

**Theme 1:** General Conceptual Framework on the General Rules Governing the Environmental Protection.

**Theme 2:** The International Obligations for the Marine Environment Protection.

**Theme 3:** A Review of the National Legislations Relating to the Marine Environment Protection.

**Theme 4:** The Legal and Institutional Mechanisms for the Marine Environment Protection.

**Theme 5:** The Role of the Judiciary in Reinforcing the Legal Protection of the Marine Environment.

## Participation Conditions:

- The presentation should not be submitted at another conference or for publish.
- The submitted presentation must be related to one of the national conference themes.
- The presentation should be attached to an abstract in a foreign language other than the conference ones.
- The abstracts should be edit in:  
**Arabic language:** version of Microsoft Word, using skkal Majalla font, size 16(headers) and 12(footnotes), with a line spacing of 1.5 cm.  
**Foreign language:** Time New Roman font, size 14(headers) and 12(footnotes), with margins of 2 cm all around.
- The number of pages should not be less than 10 pages and not exceed 15 pages.
- The presentations are subject to arbitration by the scientific committee and they will reply the acceptable ones.
- The presentations must be sent on time.
- The joint presentations are not accepted; except for the PhD students with their supervisors and only with one presentation.
